Prevention and Treatment of skin breakdown associated with the use of facial PPE







Apply a moisturising cream twice daily (before and after work) to the affected areas (i.e. face and ears).

- Apply a **thin layer** of cream to clean and dry skin and massage in gently
- Apply cream at least **30 min before** using a face mask to ensure the skin is **completely dry**
- Avoid the use of make-up and remove excess facial hair

Stay well hydrated.

Offload pressure by removing and discarding the mask every 4 hours. Discard the mask in appropriate clinical waste.

Follow Trust Guidance on mask fitting. Avoid over tightening.

In addition if needed:

Apply a Barrier Film or cream to areas likely to become moist from sweat/perspiration (i.e forehead)

- Allow 90 sec to dry
- Avoid using around the eye area and on the eyelids

Apply additional strips of silicone tape (i.e. Siltape or Mepitac)

- A Barrier film can be applied under the tape to improve adherence if needed

Treatment (Broken Skin)

If there is evidence of deep tissue injury (bruising) or open wounds, please report this to your manager and complete a DATIX incident form (health and safety > skin damage related to PPE) detailing type and make of mask.

Apply a thin foam dressing (i.e. Mepilex lite) or Hydrocolloid (i.e. DuoDerm Extra Thin)





Cut dressing to size, leaving a 1cm border to the wound margin.
The maximum wear time is 7 days.

- Alternate mask shapes (FIT tests are required for each) and consider a hood

Repeat FIT testing is required after dressings have been applied

Offload pressure by removing and discarding the mask every 2 hours.
